



# END-OF-LIFE CARE The Authority provided guidance and seminars,

195 centres

a judgment framework, and a self-assessment questionnaire

84% of centres were fully or substantially compliant \* This refers to all inspections carried out in 2014, including 195 thematic inspections analysed. End-orlife care was analysed in 498 inspections and food and nutrition in 527 inspections.

### The Authority received 609 items of unsolicited information on 303 designated centres in 2014, an increase of 71% over 2013 Of these, 55% were received from relatives of residents


