As discussed at today's meeting identified non-compliance with key regulations before the onset of the current public health emergency may be useful information in the context of centres (public and private) that may be more likely to run into difficulties now.

Key regulations in the context of a public health emergency include

- Regulation 23 Governance and management
- Regulation 27 Infection control
- Regulation 26 Risk Management
- Premises 17

I have also included regulations 9 and 12, residents rights and personal possessions as a measure of centres challenged to provide sufficient personal space to residents which would likely have implications in the current climate.
