

National Public Engagement Survey on Health Information

HIQA, in partnership with the Department of Health and the HSE, is conducting a national telephone survey on the collection, use and sharing of health information.

1,200 people will be surveyed between October and December 2020.

We will use the findings to improve health information and patient safety in Ireland.

We're also engaging with the public on health information through:

Cognitive testing of the survey with patients and the public.

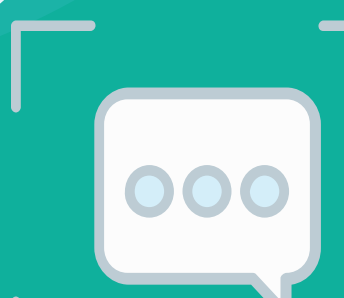


25 interviews with healthcare professionals from a wide range of professions.

6-week public consultation on draft recommendations on a model for the collection, use and sharing of health information.



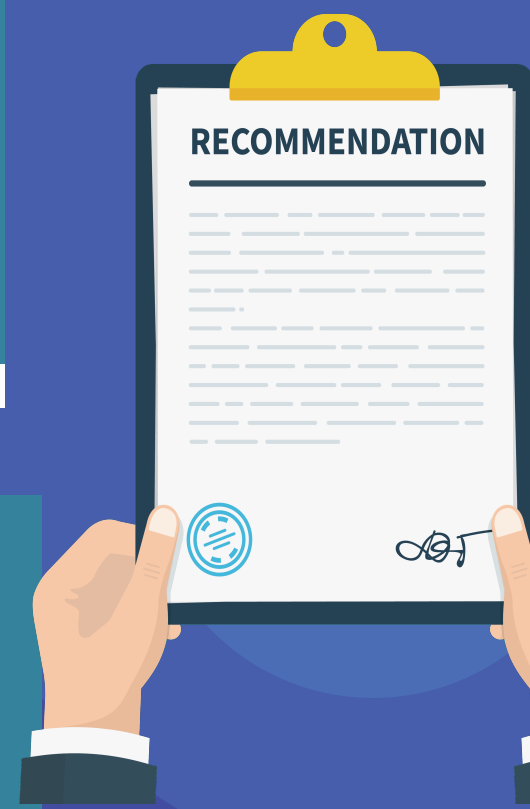
Findings will be used
