out to assess the diagnostic performance and clinical utility of multiplex antigen nearpatient tests before further decisions on their use in primary and residential care settings can be made.



For multiplex antigen tests

the evidence was limited, and the advantages, disadvantages, feasibility and acceptability of their use in residential and primary care settings remain unknown.
